By utilizing an all-volunteer staff and seeking assistance from individuals and organizations, the foundation is able to accomplish its mission of ensuring that the maximum amount of money donated is used for research and financial assistance for families.

FAMILIES WE HAVE HELPED THIS PAST YEAR

Jennifer Schwarz, Oswego, age 38—Diagnosed 5/09 with CML (leukemia). Received additional support with outstanding medical bills.

Jim Littleton, Frankfort, age 52—Diagnosed 9/09 with CLL (leukemia); received a stem cell transplant in 1/11. Received additional support with medical bills.

Eric Boyer, Chicago Ridge, age 23—Diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma in 11/09. Received additional support with medical bills after finishing treatment in 8/10.

Roger Peart, Hickory Hills, age 57—Diagnosed with Mantle Cell Lymphoma in 7/09. After being treated with chemo and radiation, he received a stem cell transplant in 2/10 and is now doing well. Received financial support with medical bills.

Becca Mueller, LaGrange Park, age 7—Diagnosed with AML and ALL (leukemia) in 8/10. She has had several rounds of chemo and some complications along the way but is now doing well with treatments.

Daniel Cavazos, Bolingbrook, age 5—Diagnosed with high-risk ALL (leukemia) in 9/07 and relapsed in 9/09. Currently searching for a bone marrow donor for him, as no family members matched.

Pamela Bartle, Blue Island, age 49—Diagnosed with CLL (leukemia) in 2006. After 4 years of treatment, she received a stem cell transplant in 11/10. Unfortunately, Pamela lost her battle in 2/11.

Taylor Kanas, Troy, MI, age 26—Diagnosed with a very rare form of Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma in 10/10. After 6 rounds of chemo, she will receive an autologous stem cell transplant. Received financial support with mounting medical bills.

Kelly Purcell, Chicago, age 40—Diagnosed with Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma in 9/10, just after getting married. Received financial support with her medical bills.

Alicia Tebo, Tinley Park, age 16—Diagnosed with Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma in 11/10. Insurance will not cover all expenses, so financial support was provided to help with the medical bills.

Alexander Kondraschow, Darien, age 58—Diagnosed with ALL (leukemia) in 5/10. He received a stem cell transplant in 10/10 and is doing well. Received financial support with medical bills as his insurance did not cover 100% of the transplant.

Ashley Gustafik, Orland Park, age 11—Diagnosed with MDS (Myelodysplastic Syndrome) in 12/10. This can develop into AML (leukemia). Currently searching for a bone marrow match for her. She was successfully treated for a brain tumor at 6 months of age.

Frank Enriquez, Manhattan, age 39—Diagnosed with AML (leukemia) in 1/10. He was treated and in remission, but recently relapsed and received a stem cell transplant in 4/11. He has a 3-year-old daughter and 1-year-old twin daughters.
